**A BILL**

To allow Members of Congress to carry a concealed firearm anywhere in the United States, with certain exceptions.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Congressional Self-  
5       Defense Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. CARRYING OF CONCEALED FIREARMS BY MEMBERS**  
2 **OF CONGRESS.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 44 of title 18, United  
4 States Code, is amended by inserting after section 926C  
5 the following:

6 **“§ 926D. Carrying of concealed firearms by Members**  
7 **of Congress**

8 “(a) Notwithstanding any other provision of Federal  
9 law or any law, rule, or regulation of a State or any polit-  
10 ical subdivision thereof, a Member of Congress who is car-  
11 rying the identification required by subsection (b) and who  
12 is not otherwise prohibited by this chapter from trans-  
13 porting, shipping, or receiving a firearm may carry a con-  
14 cealed firearm for any lawful purpose—

15 “(1) in the United States Capitol only as au-  
16 thorized by regulations issued under section  
17 5104(e)(1)(A) of title 40; and

18 “(2) anywhere else in the United States, except  
19 where the United States Secret Service is protecting  
20 the President or Vice President of the United States  
21 and prohibiting the possession of a firearm.

22 “(b) The identification required by this subsection is  
23 a valid identification document (as defined in section  
24 1028(d)(3) of this title) of the Member of Congress con-  
25 taining a photograph of the Member of Congress.

1           “(c) In this section, the term ‘Member of Congress’  
2 means a Senator or a Representative in, or Delegate or  
3 Resident Commissioner to, the Congress.”.

4           (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections  
5 for such chapter is amended by inserting after the item  
6 relating to section 926C the following:

“926D. Carrying of concealed firearms by Members of Congress.”.
